Transfer Station Policies and
Regulations
Revised September 2014

1. The designated Transfer Station for the duly permitted residents of the Town of Medfield is located at 123 North Meadows Road. A sticker is REQUIRED.
2. The Transfer Station area is for the disposal of refuse generated only in the Town of Medfield, or in accordance with any reciprocal emergency management agreement with another municipality.
3. The Superintendent of Public Works shall act as agent for the Board of Selectmen for administration of the Transfer Station.
4. The Attendant in Charge shall be obeyed at all times and materials shall be deposited in accordance with his/her instructions or in the absence of specific instructions as directed by signs. Refuse shall be cleanly and completely deposited at the designated locations unless directed otherwise by the Attendant in Charge. The Attendant is authorized upon an individual's failure to satisfactorily establish the origin of refuse, to prohibit the disposal in the transfer station. The Attendant in Charge is also authorized to request evidence that a vehicle is registered or principally garaged in Medfield.
5. All refuse deposited in the Transfer Station area becomes the property of the Town of Medfield. Commercial salvage rights may be issued by the Board of Selectmen for such fees and under such conditions that it may determine.
6. Items of refuse may be removed by individuals subject to the approval of the Attendant in Charge.

7. Areas shall be maintained to receive recyclables including (when markets are available), but not limited to, old newsprint, aluminum, glass, metal cans, plastics, returnable plastic, cardboard and aluminum beverage containers, used clothing, white goods and yard waste.

8. No person shall set fire to any materials in the Transfer Station area and no person shall deposit any ashes that are not completely extinguished.

9. No person shall discharge a firearm within the Transfer Station area.

Recycling Requirements

Rigid Plastics Recycling: Bulky, rigid, molded plastic items such as crates, buckets, toys and lawn furniture.

Used Clothing: serviceable used clothing may be deposited in the containers provided by charitable organizations.

White Goods: all metal appliances that are bulky in size (i.e. stoves, washers, dryers, residential freezers, dishwashers, hot water heaters, etc.) shall be deposited in the designated white goods pile. Please remove all doors.

Yard Waste: leaves, grass and garden clippings shall be deposited in the designated areas. All brush, branches and limbs must be eight (8) inches or less in diameter. NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES.

Electronic Equipment

The Town of Medfield has partnered with Electronix Redux Corporation for all electronic recycling, such as all computer components, printers, television sets (small fee applied), all cables and wires, telephones including Cellular.

Electronix Redux Corporation is at the Transfer Station from 9am – 2pm, the first (1st) Saturday of each month.

Household Hazardous Waste Collection **Annually in the Spring**

Oil based paint – must be dried

Household Chemicals

Waste Oil: Used motor oil, containing no contaminants other than those associated with normal use in a motor vehicle engine.

Violation

Any person violating the Policies and Regulations shall be fined as indicated:

First offense - \$25.00

Second offense - \$50.00

Subsequent offenses - \$100.00

The Transfer Station is open to all residents of the Town of Medfield with a VALID STICKER. Special permits/passes can be addressed to the Superintendent of Public Works, at 508-906-3002.

1. Applications can be obtained on line at www.town.medfield.net
2. You may mail the application or bring the application to the DPW office.
3. Please have your registration for the vehicle(s). Leased cars and card that are not registered in Medfield, please attach a copy of your insurance stating that your vehicle is principal garaged in Medfield.
4. We accept cash or check, no credit or debit cards.
5. The Transfer Station sticker must be permanently affixed to the lower corner of the driver's side front windshield.

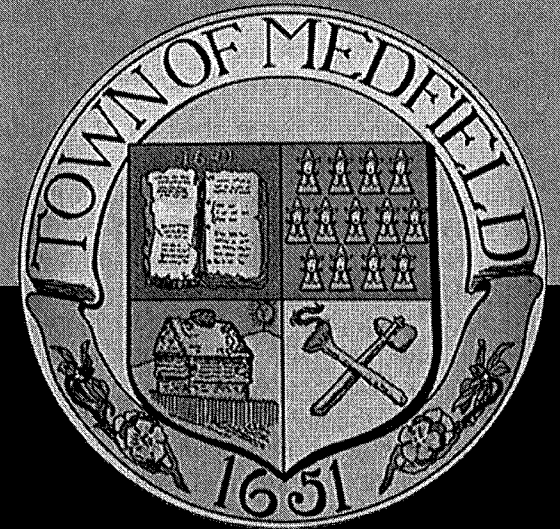
