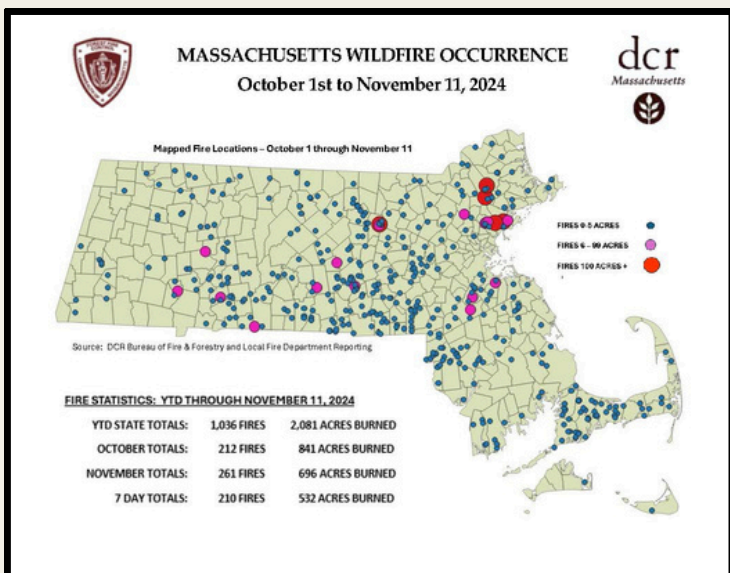

Roadway Design Projects

Town received Complete Streets Award for \$500,000

- MassDOT notified the Town that the Tier 3 Submission for the Complete Streets Funding Program has been approved.
- Projects include:
 - Sidewalk on Dale between Grove and Charlesdale
 - Sidewalk on Winter to Pine, between North and Flint Locke Lane
 - Sidewalk on Adams between Memorial School and West Street

Trinity Financial Update

- Trinity Financial is advancing the Medfield State Hospital redevelopment project with key milestones underway. A submission to the National Park Service is being prepared to close out conditions from the Part II approval, including clarifications on roofing, flashing, stair towers, porches, and flooring. The design development set of building plans will be completed by December 31, 2024, alongside VHB's infrastructure plans, which will be reviewed by the Town prior to a Supplemental MEPA filing. Geotechnical and hazardous materials testing began in October, and the team is collaborating closely with Town officials on infrastructure and planning. Finally, the project received \$500,000 from EOHLC.
