John Walsh of Walpole is a builder who applied for a permit to demolish the 1880 two-family house at 40 Park Street.

At the August 24, 2022, hearing, the historical commission declared the house historically significant and preferably preserved, and in keeping with the demolition delay bylaw, the commission imposed an 18-month delay.

Mr. Walsh has requested this September 21 meeting for the purpose of presenting additional evidence for why the demolition delay should be lifted.
